
Route Direction

This walk begins in Teynham at the railway station where there is a small public car park. Street parking is also available in both Station Road & Lower Road.

1. The walk starts at the Teynham railway station. Walk through the car park and cross the tracks via the level crossing or footbridge. Continue straight ahead for about 55yds (50m) and take the footpath on the RIGHT, along a narrow fenced path between pastures. At the 'T' junction of paths turn RIGHT, leading up to a metalled drive. Turn LEFT onto it.
2. Continue past the ISP school where the road bears left toward a farmyard. Turn RIGHT, through the yard to meet Conyer Road. Turn RIGHT onto the road. Cross the road and where it bends round to the RIGHT turn LEFT onto a marked footpath.
3. Follow the path straight ahead toward the church. (St. Mary's @ Teynham) Go through the church yard and follow the path round to the left of the church and turn LEFT down to a gate into an orchard and toward the houses ahead.
4. Turn LEFT onto the road (Teynham Street) and continue to the road junction by Banks Farm. Go straight ahead to where the road bends to the RIGHT and take the footpath on the LEFT, immediately under the power lines. Go through the kissing gate into a field and aim toward the large Himalayan Cedar tree. Go through the kissing gate behind the tree into a narrow path beside a wooden fence leading to the road. (Conyer Road)

5. Turn LEFT, continue to The Quay and turn RIGHT. Follow this road, passing The Ship pub and after approximately 175 yds (160m) further on, go through the kissing gate beside a wider gate.
6. Go straight ahead on this metalled track to where it divides and take the RIGHT fork where, after a few steps becomes a grass path. Follow this path between hedges, to a kissing gate. Go through the gate onto a wide grass bank leading toward The Swale approximately 275yds (250m) ahead. Turn LEFT through the kissing gate and continue to follow the river bank with the water on the RIGHT now becoming Conyer Creek.
7. Continue on this path, back toward Conyer. As the path leaves the creek side it meets a metalled path, turn RIGHT onto this and retrace the route back to The Quay at the junction with Conyer Road. (point 5 above)
8. Do Not turn onto Conyer Road but go straight ahead onto a waymarked footpath, between a green BT box and The Moorings road sign. *Do not take the more obvious footpath to the RIGHT.* This is a narrow path until it reaches a kissing gate which leads into open fields. Go through this gate and keeping to the LEFT edge of the fields, continue ahead, crossing a wooden footbridge and going through a number of kissing gates until reaching an open area where a number of tracks meet.
9. Continue straight ahead, passing the water treatment works entrance on the RIGHT. After a few steps the path becomes very narrow and enclosed between a hedge and fence. Follow this round until it reaches the row of houses. (Station Row) Walk along the front of the houses and continue on back to the railway station.

Out to Conyer Creek from Teynham

A level 4.5 mile 7.25K) walk out to Conyer Creek through apple orchards and quiet country lanes. St Mary's church is en route and worth a visit as is The Ship public house at Conyer.
